



Tablet and Internet Usage Charter in primary School

This charter is signed by one of the parents or the tutor of the student enrolled in a primary school class at Mondorf-les-Bains International School. It takes effect on the day of its signature and remains valid until the pupil quits school or until a new version of the charter comes into effect.

The tablets are the property of the School and made available to students by the School. All users must respect this charter.

1. The tablet is a learning and working tool and is therefore intended for use at school.
2. The settings of the tablet can only be changed with the teacher's consent.
3. The tablet is fragile and must be used with care: the protective shell must not be removed under any circumstances. The keyboard and the pen are to be used and kept with the same care.
4. No personal data can be stored in the tablet: photos, recordings etc. ...
5. The tablet access code is set by the teacher and cannot be changed.
6. Installed applications must not be deleted.
7. The tablet must be stored and recharged at the end of the day.
8. The tablet cannot be taken home. However, an exceptional permission may be granted by the teacher. In this case, the teacher will first ask the agreement of the parents.
9. The sharing of photos or documents with other pupils can only be done with the teacher's agreement.
10. The tablet cannot be used outside the classroom. An exceptional permission may be requested from the teacher.
11. Internet can only be used as part of a school assignment: to make a research or go to a site indicated by the teacher. Online gaming is not allowed.
12. Pupils must not give information about their name, age or address on any website or in any app.
13. The creation of new accounts on the tablet or on the internet is not allowed.
14. Content identified on the Internet and deemed problematic or disturbing must be reported immediately to the teacher.
15. Any photograph or video shoot requires the prior agreement of all persons who will appear in an identifiable manner.
16. Any use by a pupil of a tablet for illegal or morally offensive purposes will be immediately reported.

As the tablets are the property of the School, they can be checked at any time by teachers, educators and management to verify compliance with the charter.

In case of non-compliance with the charter, three warnings will be issued:

1. At each warning, parents will be informed of the non-respect of the charter.
2. After two warnings, access to the tablet will be denied for the week.
3. At the third warning, the tablet will be denied for the semester.
