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Process of progression to a superior league

If a learner wants to progress to a higher league, they talk to their tutor during their weekly meeting. If the tutor is confident that the progression can succeed, the following progress contract is completed and signed by the learner and his tutor.

In addition to the signature of their tutor, learners must gather four other signatures. Two of the signatories must be class teachers of the learners. The other two signatures may come from any other EIMLB teacher who has already mentored the learner in any class or activity.

Teachers can support or reject the learners' progress request and indicate why they think so. If one of the teachers does not support the request, it is refused.

If all signatory teachers agree, the reference period for progression begins. Over the following three weeks, teachers will pay particular attention to ensuring that the learners comply with all the duties related to the league they want to reach.

During the reference period, the rights and obligations of the league already apply. If learners fail more than twice to comply with any of the new status obligations, the reference period is terminated and the learners' request is refused.

If the learners comply with all the obligations, they are officially advanced to the new league. The progress is implemented and the training contract is archived. The learner also receives the emblem of his new league.

Process of reclassification to a lower league

If learners do not meet the requirements of their current league, they may be deprived of it and may be re-assigned to the immediately lower league, or even the league that best suits the behavioral issues at stake.

The reason for the reclassification does not need to be explicitly indicated in the contract or in the obligations related to the respective league, for example in case of general non-respect of the school charter. The reason must nevertheless be clearly explained in an interview between the learners and their tutor.

The reclassification can be pronounced only by the personal tutor or the direction of the school. All other teachers can only make recommendations.

A reclassification does not need to be announced and should be pronounced immediately after the fact-finding. The reclassification is implemented and the parents should be informed.

§1 - In addition to the rights linked to the "WOOD league", learners in "BRONZE league" have the right to ...

- use their iPad with advanced features (*bridled* Safari, Office, Lens, Camera, Photos, Restopolis, WebUntis, Kahoot, Khanacademy, ...);
- work on their own initiative on classroom materials available in the classroom;
- borrow resources from the library;
- use any application related to a specific extracurricular activity.

§2a - Learners in the "WOOD league" have to ...

- respect the school charter;
- respect the digital charter;
- respect the rules of interaction of their class;
- respect the personal commitments they make with their tutor;
- regularly write in their DALTON agenda and have it signed by their legal representative;
- actively participate in class;
- work regularly on their missions;
- keep their workplace clean with the support of their tutor;
- interact respectfully with others (students, teachers, staff, including Restopolis staff and cleaning personnel) and equipment.

§2b - In addition to the obligations linked to the "WOOD league", learners in "BRONZE league" have to ...

- mark for visible identification his digital material (tablet, keyboard and pen);
- actively participate in a MESADay/TabletDay workshop, an open-house event or in any other official school event;
- make a tutorial about an aspect of school life – that has not yet been dealt with in the directory of tutorials: an operation on the iPad, a technique learned during an activity, etc.

§3 - The present progress contract is canceled in case the learner

- fails - more than twice - to fulfill all the duties stipulated above during the reference period of 3 weeks starting from the date of signature of this contract. This includes entries in the class book and the protocol attached below.
- acts against the rules, agreements and principles of the school community, even if they are not specifically listed above.
