MESA



Principles

- M = motivation E = education S = social A = accompanying

Missions

- Organisation of
 - socio-educational projects in close collaboration with teachers
 - educational activities, special days (MESAdays) and school holidays
 - information and prevention sessions (Police, Bee Secure etc.)
- Participation, organisation and coordination of extracurricular activities
- Regular follow-up and educational supervision of learners with academic, personal and educational difficulties
- Accompaniment of class assemblies and school parliament
- Collaboration and exchange of information with all members of the school community (management, teachers, students, parents, external services)
- Participation in the School Development Unit (CDS)
- Collaboration with other external services (Munnerefer Jugendstuff, clubs sportifs de Mondorf-les-Bains etc.)

KiVa antibullying program



Principles

- Prevention, intervention and follow-up to
 - prevent harassment
 - address and solve harassment cases in a sustainable manner
 - continuously monitor the atmosphere at the school and changes over time
- Annual feedback via online tools

The main elements of KiVa

- General action, such as the KiVa program (teaching units for pupils and online games) to prevent harassment
- Specific action once harassment has been reported
- Based on decades of research on harassment and its mechanisms
- Evidence of effectiveness based on studies

Proceedings

- KiVa is aimed at different age groups
 - Unit 1 (learners from 6 to 9 years)
 - Unit 2 (learners from 10 to 12 years)
 - Unit 3 (after the transition from primary to lower secondary school ; learners from 13 to 16 years)
- Material for teachers, students and parents
 - teacher manuals, videos, online games, KiVa student and staff surveys, posters, vests and parent guide
 - several language versions available

KiVa is not meant to be a one-year project, but a permanent part of the school's anti-bullying policy.
